Environmental Assessment (Scotland) Act 2005 01474 Screening – Perth and Kinross Council – Forest and Woodland Strategy supplementary guidance

Thank you for your screening consultation submitted via the Scottish Government SEA Gateway in respect of the above plan. In accordance with Section 9(3) of the Environmental Assessment (Scotland) Act 2005, we have considered your screening report using the criteria set out in Schedule 2 for determining the likely significance of effects on the environment.

The screening report details the minor updates which are proposed to the existing Strategy. It states that the previous SEA is still relevant and provides a thorough and detailed environmental assessment of the guidance. We note that the overall strategy, vision and objectives will remain unchanged and the existing strategic framework will also be carried forward unchanged.
