

Delivery Plan Consultation

The need to develop a strategy to support parents in their parenting roles was initially highlighted as an action in the Tayside Plan for Children Young People and Families. And following consultation with parents, those with a parenting role and service providers across Tayside, the Tayside Strategy for Parents was developed in 2019.

The strategy is a commitment by partner organisations in Tayside that deliver services for children, young people and families to work together with parents to improve the information, services and community developments that support families to live positive outcomes.

Four improvement priorities were identified through consultation, these have now been incorporated into a draft delivery plan.

- Parents have access to good quality information that supports them to make informed choices, plan for and meet their family's needs.
- Communities are inclusive, understand children's needs and support families to thrive
- Families have access to effective services that are delivered by a skilled and confident workforce that value the role of parents
- Policies that affect family life are supportive and deliver positive outcomes.

We now want to consult parents on the actions we believe will deliver change in the four priorities areas and want to hear your views about whether or not you feel these will help improve the experience of parents and outcomes for families.

The strategy recognises parents as equal partners, and this has been reflected in the draft delivery plan. To help make this happen we have created a Parenting Offer which focusses on what both Services and parents can do to support each other to make the biggest difference and we also want your feedback on this approach.
