
Perth and Kinross HSCP General Practice Premises Public Survey Analysis

Rating practice building

We asked respondents to rate their registered GP practice building 1 to 5 (1=poor - 5=great) in the following: Well designed and functional. wheelchair or mobility access and general environment.

Over 70% (n = 1436) of respondents gave the design and function a rating of 4 to 5

Over 65% (n = 1325) of respondents gave the wheelchair or mobility access a rating of 4 to 5

Over 68% (n = 1385) of respondents gave the general environment a rating of 4 to 5
