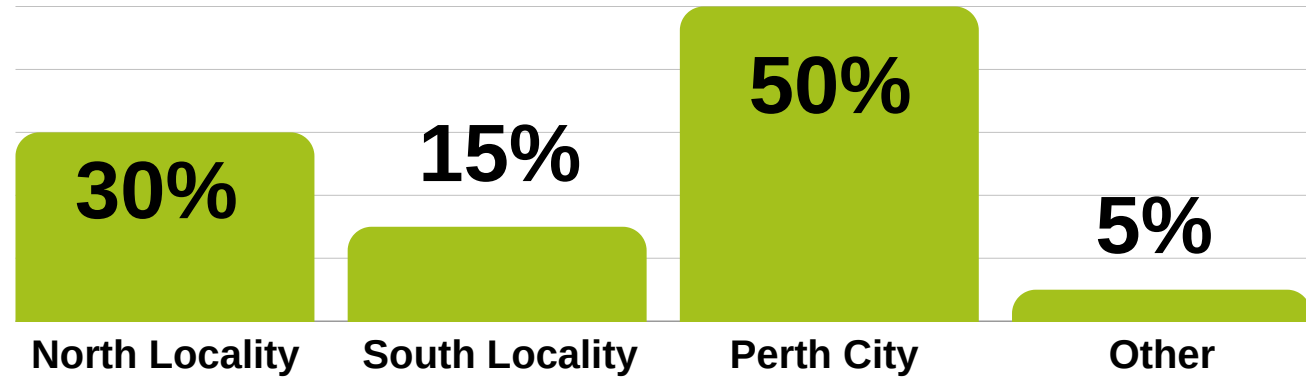


# Perth and Kinross HSCP General Practice Premises Public Survey Analysis

## Response rate per practice

A total of 2034 responses of which 52% (1074) came from 8 practices out of 23.



For a more detailed look at the practices, see the full report.

80% (1613) of respondents live within 5 miles of their registered practice.



70% (1469) of respondents travel time to their registered practice is no more than 15 mins.

Does your registered GP Practice building have adequate parking?

Yes - 75%

No - 18%

Not applicable to me - 7%

## Rating practice building

We asked respondents to rate their registered GP practice building 1 to 5 (1=poor - 5=great) in the following: **Well designed and functional, wheelchair or mobility access and general environment.**

Over 70% (n = 1436) of respondents gave the design and function a rating of 4 to 5

Over 65% (n = 1325) of respondents gave the wheelchair or mobility access a rating of 4 to 5

Over 68% (n = 1385) of respondents gave the general environment a rating of 4 to 5

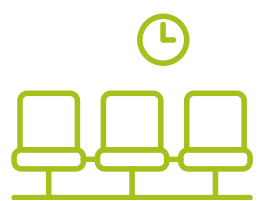

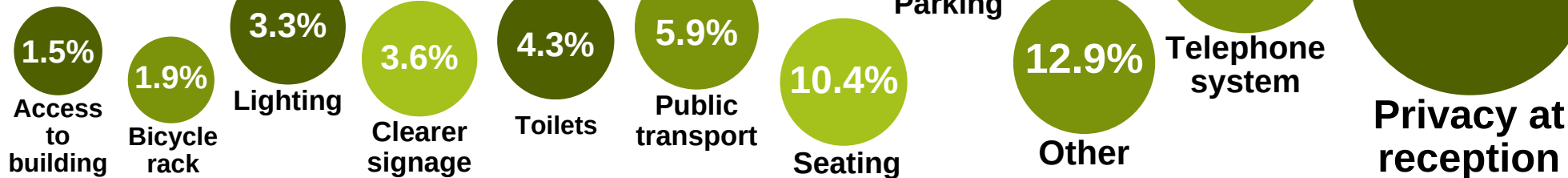
